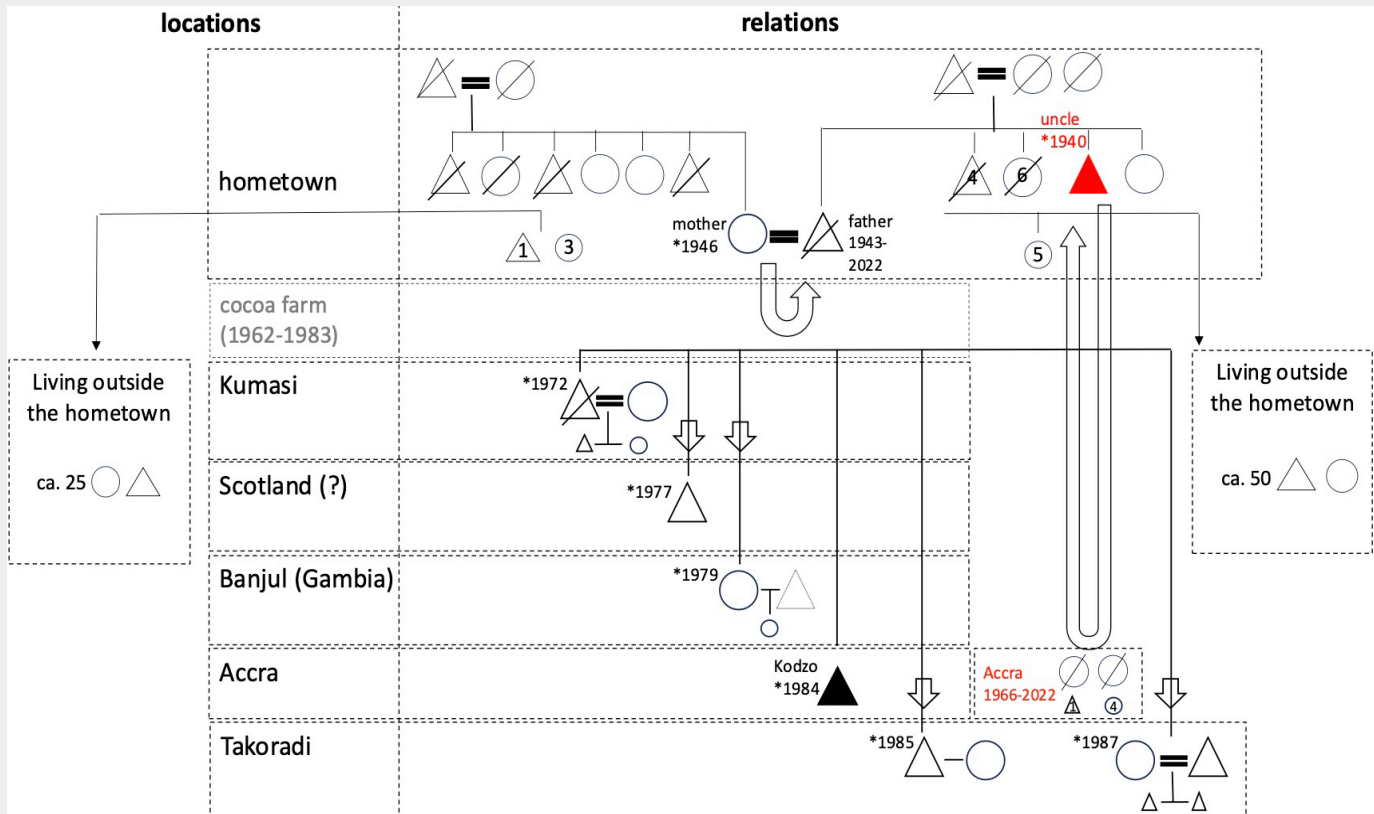


Lecture series: Society in Transformation

This presentation considers absence as a site of social and affective tensions in West African migration. Focusing on a family of six siblings who have all migrated and their ageing parents who stayed put, it traces the family's relations over time and distances to show how absence intersects with reckonings of kinship, value and existence in unexpected ways, creating new dynamics and dilemmas around belonging and social viability.
